Registration Information

Welcome to The School of Performing Arts! In order for everyone to have a rewarding experience, we ask that all students and parents read and agree to the following conditions.

Students are encouraged and expected to attend class regularly. **Dance** students are entitled to make up missed classes during the current session at equivalent level or below. Private **music** lessons canceled less than 24 hours ahead of time will not be made up. Make ups for missed private **music** lessons are at the discretion of the instructor. Please see school administrator with make up inquiries.

All students are expected to arrive on time and come prepared for all classes. **Theatre** students must come with the appropriate equipment (music, script, pencil) and ready to work. Due to the nature of some **theatre** classes with a performance, you may be asked to supply some sort of prop, costume piece, etc. You will get plenty of notice from the instructor if this is necessary. **Music** students must come with all of their materials (music, instrument, and pencil) and ready to work. Students are expected to practice their lesson material outside of class. This is imperative for progress to occur. **Music** teachers reserve the right to terminate lessons if there is a consistent lack of preparation. **Dance** students should attend all classes dressed in appropriate attire. For questions regarding attire please consult the fall brochure, ask the school administrator or visit our website at www.schoolofperformingarts.com No food or gum chewing in any class.

Spectrum students must submit an intake form along with this registration form.

Class assignments will be determined at time of registration. Students will be evaluated during the first few weeks of classes to ensure proper placement. An interview is available with the instructor prior to the first private **music** lesson. Minimum enrollment may be required for certain classes.

Parents may observe their child's class at any time during the summer. Arrangements must be made in advance through the teacher and is at his or her discretion.

The School of Performing Arts may use any photograph, or video taken of me/my child at The School, or any performance for promotional or news media purposes. The School of Performing Arts, its faculty, and its volunteers shall be indemnified, defended and held harmless by students and guardians for any injuries and any act, claim, expense or damages arising out of or related thereof, suffered by or caused by students. The School of Performing Arts is not responsible for any lost, misplaced or stolen items.

All required fees are payable in advance and must accompany registration.

Tuition is non-refundable unless classes are cancelled for entire quarter or semester by The School, with the exception of class/lesson cancellation due to inclement weather.
There are no credits or transfers of any fees.

There is a \$35 registration fee per family, payable yearly.

There will be a \$25 fee for any returned check, and for any late payment for those **music students on the split-semester payment plan.**
