### CHECK IN

Monday, July 26, 2010

11am- check in with counselors and NCC Staff

**We will be staying in Schneller Hall (formerly the Town Homes) on the campus of North Central College – Note from NCC:** *There should be street parking on Loomis. They would prefer we DO NOT unload in the alleyway. It's very unlikely that space would be available there as I understand that the residence hall adjacent to Schneller will be undergoing window replacement this summer.*

## FINAL PERFORMANCE DETAILS

Where: Chicago Academy For the Arts, 1010 W. Chicago Avenue, 60622-5414 ***(This is a very old school with no air conditioning and lots of stairs up to the theatre space, be sure to dress cool ☺)***

Parking is available in the lot directly behind the school or there is plenty of street parking, as well. If using the lot, come down Chicago Avenue, turn north on Sangamon (at Animal Hospital), there is an alley next to the Animal Hospital, turn west into the alley, wind thru the alley (behind the animal hospital) and the parking lot is there behind the school.

***\*Enter the school in the alley entrance, which is between the school and the church.***
